SUBJECT: Displays and Written Reports for the 2012 Synod Assembly

The 2012 Synod Assembly will be held April 27-29 at the Wenatchee Convention Center. This year's theme is **GO ! Tell and Serve**. This letter gives you information specific to displays, breakfast table talks and written reports. The enclosed form will reserve your space at the assembly and/or let us know you plan to send something to go in the packets. You should have or soon will also receive a general registration packet for the assembly. If you want housing, please use the Registration Form from that packet.

Breakfast Table Talks, Displays and Reports will be your primary means to get information to the attendees about your organization/group. There will be minimal opportunity for Ministry Partners to address the assembly.

BREAKFAST TABLE TALKS: Again this year we will be giving opportunities for folks to have conversations about a variety of topics during breakfast. We put the topic up on a standard at a table and folks are invited to sit there with their breakfast and take part in the discussion. You may sign up for Saturday, Sunday or both days – with the same or different topics.

DISPLAYS: Something a little different this year, the Ministry Partner displays will be set up around the perimeter of the ballroom where the assembly will be held. We hope this gives you better visibility, allows you to attend the assembly sessions and hopefully then gives you more people stopping by before and after sessions. The synod display policy is enclosed for your information.

- We will once again be doing door prizes so would ask that you provide one or more items to be given out over the course of the assembly. We ask that you **DO NOT** hold your own drawing or raffle.
- Tables will be 6 ft in length and will be skirted and will cost \$35.
- Cost for meals only is \$150 (Friday dinner; Saturday breakfast, lunch, and dinner; Sunday breakfast)
